

SupaStuds



- **SS001 Road Stud (8mm)**
For use on the road and on hard ground. Extra-hardened to stand up to the rigours of road work. We also have a larger road stud (SS012), which is slightly longer and also has a larger surface area.
- **SS002 Small Conical Stud (16mm)**
For use in a variety of conditions. This is one of the best selling studs and is incredibly versatile.
- **SS003 Mini-Dome Stud (18mm)**
Soft ground stud – oval shape for good grip. This a little smaller than SS007 but still a good, chunky stud ideal for soft, muddy conditions.
- **SS004 Medium Conical Stud (20mm)**
Ideal for slippery grass or greasy surfaces on a hard base. Perfect when you need a bit more grip than you get from SS002, or often used in hind shoes in conjunction with SS002 in front shoes.

- **SS005 Large Conical Stud (25mm)**
 The longest stud, designed to give precision response in deep going. Show jumpers love this stud to help with tight turns on big horses in a greasy outdoor ring.
- **SS006 Bullet Stud (14mm)**
 Utility stud useful in a range of good to soft conditions. It can be used in front or behind on any size of horse or pony. A great option if you want a bit more grip than you would get from, say, SS012.
- **SS007 Maxi-Dome Stud (20mm)**
 Soft/deep going stud with oval shape for good grip. This is our largest soft ground stud and is most suitable for use in hind shoes in the softest conditions, particularly on large horses.
- **SS008 Sharp Stud**
 The best hold on the firmest ground. Tip is quite sharp when new but quickly wears to a slightly more rounded shape – this does not affect the efficiency of the stud in use.
- **SS009 Mini Sharp Stud (10mm)**
 Like a road stud but with extra penetration – a running spike for horses! Particularly suitable for sun-baked ground. Often used in front shoes with small conical studs behind.
- **SS010 Polo Stud (12mm)**
 Cubic stud, conforms to polo regulations but useful in any sport in a variety of good to soft conditions. Slightly smaller than SS006 which performs a similar function so particularly suitable for ponies.
- **SS011 Dressage Stud (14mm)**
 Conical, small radius stud originally requested by dressage riders, but another good, utility hard ground stud which has become one of the most popular styles for all disciplines.
- **SS012 Large Road Stud (9mm)**
 This is a slightly larger version of the original road stud. Extra-hardened to stand up to the rigours of road work.
- **SS013 Travel Stud (2mm)**
 Keeps stud holes free from dirt and stones. Use the night before a competition to make studding-up on the day even easier, and at competitions spread over several days. Not intended for long term use.
- **SS014 Arena Stud**
 The latest addition – The Arena Stud.
