



# Carriage Driving Body Protector

## Taking your measurements

Follow this guide for a perfect fitting body protector:

- A body protector should be fitted over light clothing and heavier garments worn over the top.
- Take your chest measurement A
- Take your waist measurement B
- Take your back measurement (waist - to – waist) D
- Refer to the Size Chart Measurement sheet and find you size.
- When fitting your body protector, loosen the chest and waist fastenings and flex the garment to soften the foam. When putting the body protector on fasten at the chest and waist, ensuring that the contrast-coloured control markers are tightened and covered.

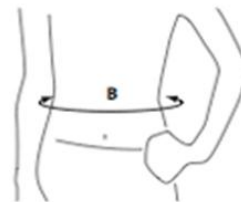
**Chest Measurement A** \_\_\_\_\_ cm

The dimension around the chest, a firm close measurement is required.



**Waist Measurement B** \_\_\_\_\_ cm

The narrowest dimension around the waist



**Back Measurement D** \_\_\_\_\_ cm

From the prominent bone at the base of the neck in a straight line to a point:

- i) if sitting in your carriage , approximately 4 fingers width clearance
- ii) if standing on your back step, to the base of your back.
